<p>Cover Page – Page 1</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Title • Format: Presentation or Poster • For each author provide: full name, institution/organization, mailing address, telephone number, fax number, email address • Include time length of the presentation - select 20 or 30 minutes 	<p>Abstract – Page 2 (Limit to one page, single-spaced, publication-ready, 12-point, Times New Roman font)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Title • Author(s) full names and institutions or organizations • Summary of the purposes, objectives, or aims; methodology or procedures; and major findings, conclusions, or evaluation
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All presenters are required to register for the conference and to pay the applicable registration fee prior to the conference. • Time allotted for the presentation will be 20 or 30 minutes (whichever you request at the time of submission on the Abstract Information Form). Presenters are encouraged to plan time for questions or discussion within this allotted time. • Posters will be on display Thursday afternoon, and presenters are asked to be available during the evening reception for poster viewing. Poster size is standard size (3’x4’). • Refer to separate attachment for information on the Student Poster Competition
