Guide for Abstract Submissions

The deadline for all submissions is April 30, 2018. Submissions must include three items:

1. Abstract Information Form
2. Cover Page
3. Abstract

<p>Cover Page (one page)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Title • For each author provide: full name, institution/organization, mailing address, telephone number, fax number, email address 	<p>Abstract (may not exceed one page)</p> <p>Abstract must be single-spaced and publication ready in 12-point Times New Roman font. The abstract should include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Title • Author(s) with full names and institutional or organizational affiliation • Summary of the purposes, objectives, or aims; methodology or procedures; and major findings, conclusions, or evaluation 						
<p>NOTES:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Presenters are required to preregister for the conference and to pay the applicable registration fee. The fee includes the cost of the Thursday TSAHP Awards Dinner. • Podium presentation authors will indicate the preferred length (20 or 30 minutes) on the Abstract Information Form. Presenters should allow for questions or discussion within this allotted time. • Posters will be on display Thursday afternoon, and presenters are expected to be available during the evening reception for poster viewing.
