



## Texas Society of Allied Health Professions Call for Abstracts

**TSAHP Annual Fall Conference - September 17-18, 2020  
UT Rio Grande Valley, Brownsville, Texas**

TSAHP cordially invites you to submit an abstract to be considered for presentation (platform presentation or the general poster session) for the annual fall conference. **Note:** a different application process exists for submissions to the Student Poster Competition.

The 2020 conference theme is “**Gearing up for Change: Educating Tomorrow’s Health Care Team.**” **Presentations should reflect the theme.** Suggestions include technology, simulation, models of supervision, preceptor engagement, paid preceptors, health system partnerships, virtual reality, AI, clinical placement, curriculum interprofessional education (IPE), disease management for the Hispanic Population, integration of public health, utilizing community engagement for student experiences and exposure to the professions, and pathways.

### Guide for Abstract Submissions

The deadline for submissions is **April 30, 2020**. Submissions must include three items:

1. Abstract Information Form
2. Cover Page
3. Abstract

#### Cover Page (one page)

- Title
- For each author provide: full name, institution/organization, mailing address, telephone number, fax number, email address

#### Abstract (may not exceed one page)

Abstract must be **Word format**, single-spaced and publication ready in 12-point Arial font. The abstract should include:

- Title
- Summary of the purposes, objectives, or aims; methodology or procedures; and major findings, conclusions, or evaluation

- Presenters (accepted) are required to preregister for the conference and will pay the member’s conference registration fee rate. The fee includes the cost of the Thursday TSAHP Awards Dinner.
- Podium presentation authors will indicate the preferred length (20 or 30 minutes) on the Abstract Information Form. Presenters should allow for questions or discussion within this allotted time.
- Posters will be on display Thursday afternoon, and presenters are expected to be available during the evening reception for poster viewing. Posters should be standard size (3’x4’).
