From Interstate 410:

Exit at Fredericksburg Road and turn north on Fredericksburg. Continue on Fredericksburg to Medical Drive. Turn left onto Medical. Turn left again onto Floyd Curl Drive, which is the second stop light on Medical. The main entrance is on the right.
