**Note: This is for faculty abstracts only. There is a different application and process for the student poster competition.**

### Guide for Abstract Submissions

The deadline for submissions is **April 30, 2026**. Submissions must include three items and may be included in one document:

1. Abstract Information Form
2. Cover Page
3. Abstract

<p><b>Cover Page (one page)</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Title</li></ul> <p>For each author provide: full name, institution/organization, mailing address, telephone number, fax number, email address</p>	<p><b>Abstract (may not exceed one page)</b></p> <p>Abstract must be <b>Word format (no pdf's, please), single-spaced and publication ready in 12-point Arial font</b>. The abstract should include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Title</li></ul> <p>Summary of the purposes, objectives, or aims; methodology or procedures; and major findings, conclusions, or evaluation</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Presenters (accepted) are required to preregister for the conference and will pay the member's conference registration fee rate. The fee includes the cost of the Thursday TSAHP Awards Dinner.</li><li>• Podium presentation authors will indicate the preferred length (20 or 30 minutes) on the Abstract Information Form. Presenters should allow for questions or discussion within this allotted time.</li><li>• Posters will be displayed online. Presenters with accepted posters will be sent instructions to record an online overview of their poster.</li><li>• All sessions will be presented by faculty (no student presenters).</li><li>• <b>Abstracts (including posters) should associate the conference theme or health professions' education.</b></li></ul>
