Call for Abstracts

TSAHP Annual Fall Conference - September 19-20, 2024
The University of Texas Health Science Center – San Antonio, Texas

TSAHP cordially invites you to submit an abstract to be considered for presentation (platform presentation or the general poster session) for the annual fall conference. **Note:** this is for faculty abstracts only. There is a different application process for the student poster competition.

The 2024 conference theme is "Cutting Edge Technologies and Emerging Practices in Health Professions and Higher Education". Key words include artificial intelligence, professionalism, mental health and wellness, technology, burnout, work life balance, ChatGPT, virtual reality, ADA considerations, 3D printing, medical technology and devices, app-based assessment tools, technical and social issues.

Guide for Abstract Submissions

The deadline for submissions is **April 30**, **2024**. Submissions must include <u>three</u> items and may be included in one document:

- 1. Abstract Information Form
- 2. Cover Page
- 3. Abstract

Cover Page (one page)

- Title
- For each author provide: full name, institution/organization, mailing address, telephone number, fax number, email address

Abstract (may not exceed one page)

Abstract must be **Word format, single-spaced and publication ready in 12-point Arial font**. The abstract should include:

- Title
- Summary of the purposes, objectives, or aims; methodology or procedures; and major findings, conclusions, or evaluation
- Presenters (accepted) are required to preregister for the conference and will pay the member's conference registration fee rate. The fee includes the cost of the Thursday TSAHP Awards Dinner.
- Podium presentation authors will indicate the preferred length (20 or 30 minutes) on the Abstract Information Form. Presenters should allow for questions or discussion within this allotted time.
- Posters will be displayed online. Presenters with accepted posters will be sent instructions to record an online overview of their poster.

SUBMIT abstract and faculty information form to: <u>TSAHP Online Portal</u> Individuals must have a Google account to submit the abstract.
